Welcome to Palmerston CRC's weekly bulletin. Today Pastor Andrew is scheduled to conclude our sermon series on the book of Philippians focusing on Philippians 4:1-23. This morning we will witness the Infant Baptism of Raelle Faye Gerrielyn Reitzema, daughter of Erik & Henrike. We also remember and celebrate other baptisms that were held earlier this year outside of the sanctuary – Arie Koersen, Bryce Pehlke and Myla Kieftenburg.

This morning we also have the privilege of celebrating Communion. Individually sealed portions of bread and juice will be available for those who will celebrate the sacrament in person. Those attending worship online in their homes are encouraged to partake of the sacrament in their homes as we remember and believe together.

We've Opened Up the Overflow! As more people choose to join us for in-person worship on Sunday mornings, we've taken steps to accommodate the larger numbers by opening the wall between the sanctuary and the fellowship hall (multi-purpose room). The overflow area has been set up with some tables and chairs especially meant for use by families with young children. These tables can be reserved on the worship service registration form (<http://palmerstoncrc.com/worship-service-registration-page>). The registration form has also been updated to allow you to register as a family rather than as individuals. While opening our sanctuary raises our maximum number of attendees to 100 we will continue to live stream and record services for those who need to, or prefer to, remain in their homes during the pandemic. We want to encourage everyone to worship on Sundays regardless of where you are. Registration closes at 3pm on Fridays and is on a first come, first serve basis. Based on the advice of the Public Health Unit for Wellington-Dufferin Guelph, all attendees are required to wear a mask and maintain a 2-meter physical distancing and congregational singing is also suspended. Our services will continue to be live streamed, so those who are not comfortable returning or who are unable to return can continue to worship with us. If there are issues with the live stream a seamless video will be posted to Palmerston CRC website (YouTube video) after the service on Sunday afternoon.
